## Conditions of Entry-

1. The competition shall be conducted under current Australian Alpaca Association Ltd Showing Rules and all decisions on any matter in connection with or arising out of the competition shall be binding on the Exhibitor.
2. **Exhibitors are required to be familiar with these Rules and by signing the Entry Form acknowledge that they understand these rules.**
3. The registered owner of an exhibit must be a financial member of the AAA Ltd.
4. Alpacas travelling interstate must comply with that State's Department of Industry requirements.
5. All alpacas must be registered with the A.A.A. Ltd and IAR number quoted on the entry form. Entry forms must be accompanied by photocopy of each alpacas registration certificate (both sides)
6. All alpacas entered must have the relevant IAR tag present in the ear or if the tag has been recently lost, the owner must supply a copy of letter of authority issued by AAA National Office. Failure to provide this authority at the time the animal is inspected will result in disqualification of the animal.
7. The exhibitor or their representative must complete, sign and forward the Entry Form and **Alpaca Herd Health Status Declaration for Shows and Sales** in order to declare that any alpaca entered is healthy and free from disease or is from a herd which has had a negative whole herd faecal culture test and that no contact with infected animals or properties has been made within the past twenty-four months.
8. The Chief Steward or Inspection Steward has the ultimate power to transfer an exhibit to another class, to inspect each exhibit for identity and any disqualifying faults and to transfer an exhibit to another class if deemed appropriate in his/her opinion.
9. Any animal that, in the opinion of the Chief Steward, is not in a fit state to be exhibited may be rejected by them and debarred from competing in the class or classes for which it is entered. Any alpaca so designated must be removed from the showgrounds as soon as the Exhibitor is notified. Any alpaca found to have lice infestation must be removed from the showgrounds immediately along with any other alpacas present that belong to the same exhibitor or have shared travelling or pen arrangements.
10. The use of hormones and/or tranquilisers is prohibited. The Chief Steward at their discretion will disqualify any exhibitor violating this regulation.
11. The age of alpacas is to be calculated from the birth date shown on the registration certificate up to show judging day. (ie 29th August 2010)
12. All alpacas shall be fed, watered and attended to by the Exhibitor while the animals remain on the showgrounds. Animals will be penned on grassed areas and therefore **bedding straw will not be provided.**
13. No animals may be removed before judging is concluded (not withstanding the exception outlined in condition #9). Permission to remove animals prior to this time due to exceptional circumstances must be sought from the show convener.
14. In the event of the judge deciding that the exhibits in any class or championship are not worthy of the prize, no prize or ribbon shall be awarded.
15. Maximum fleece length recommended for huacaya- no more than 130mm. Huacaya 12 months and older must be shorn regularly so that no more than 15 months fleece is carried at the time of showing. Maximum fleece length for suri- to be assessed by the judge. A suri must be shorn regularly so that no more than 24 months fleece is carried at the time of showing.
16. Classes will be joined if numbers warrant. There must be a minimum of 3 animals in any age class or classes may be joined to most suitable colour.
17. Sire progeny class comprises two or more groups of 2 males or females (not wethers) six months and over, not necessarily owned or bred by the one exhibitor, but all the progeny of the one sire drawn from ordinary classes. These can be entered before 9 am for suri, or noon for Huacaya on the day of the show.
18. No dogs or companion animals are permitted within the penning or showing precinct. Working guide dogs are exempt.
19. All attendants leading stock in the judging ring shall wear a white coat over long black trousers or long skirt, with clean dress shoes or boots. The chief steward may disqualify an exhibitor for incorrect attire.
